

# WORKSHOP THE VALUE OF CLIMATE SERVICES FOR TOURISM



## **Presentation**

Meteorological conditions determine the viability and competitiveness of socio-economic activities of any territory for many, like the tourist, reason why the co-development of climate services with local agents becomes necessary.

Climate services are understood as the transmission of processed information from meteorological and climatological data in a way that becomes useful for the end-user in the decision-making process. This can apply both for the short, medium and long term, and should be useful to trigger actions that adapt tourism activity to long-term trends and sudden changes of the competitive context, or else mitigate the effects that tourism generates on climatic conditions.

In the framework of INDECIS, researchers have been carried out different workshops for co-designing with stakeholders climate services in European tourism destinations, with the participation of public and private agents of the territory, of users and tourists.
